

BC OGRIS/REMB Telemetry Data Read Me First

Introduction

These files contain telemetry data collected from the Research and Effectiveness Monitoring Board's (REMB) boreal caribou radio-collaring program. The program has been monitoring the habitat use, survival and recruitment of boreal caribou in each of 6 ranges in Northeast B.C. since 2013.

Telemetry Data

Data provided contains telemetry information collected from radio collars deployed on over 200 boreal caribou and 40 wolves since 2013. Two files are available—telemetry data collected from boreal caribou radio collars and telemetry data collected from radio collars on wolves.
