

## BC OGRIS/REMB Telemetry Data Read Me First

### Introduction

These files contain telemetry data collected from the Research and Effectiveness Monitoring Board's (REMB) boreal caribou radio-collaring program. The program has been monitoring the habitat use, survival and recruitment of boreal caribou in each of 6 ranges in Northeast B.C. Additional radio-collars are deployed annually to maintain a consistent sampling effort.

### Telemetry Data

Telemetry data are available for each calendar year, starting in 2013. The current year's file is updated quarterly.

The telemetry data files are in Google earth format (<https://www.google.com/earth/>). Some attributes have been removed to respect data-sharing agreements.
