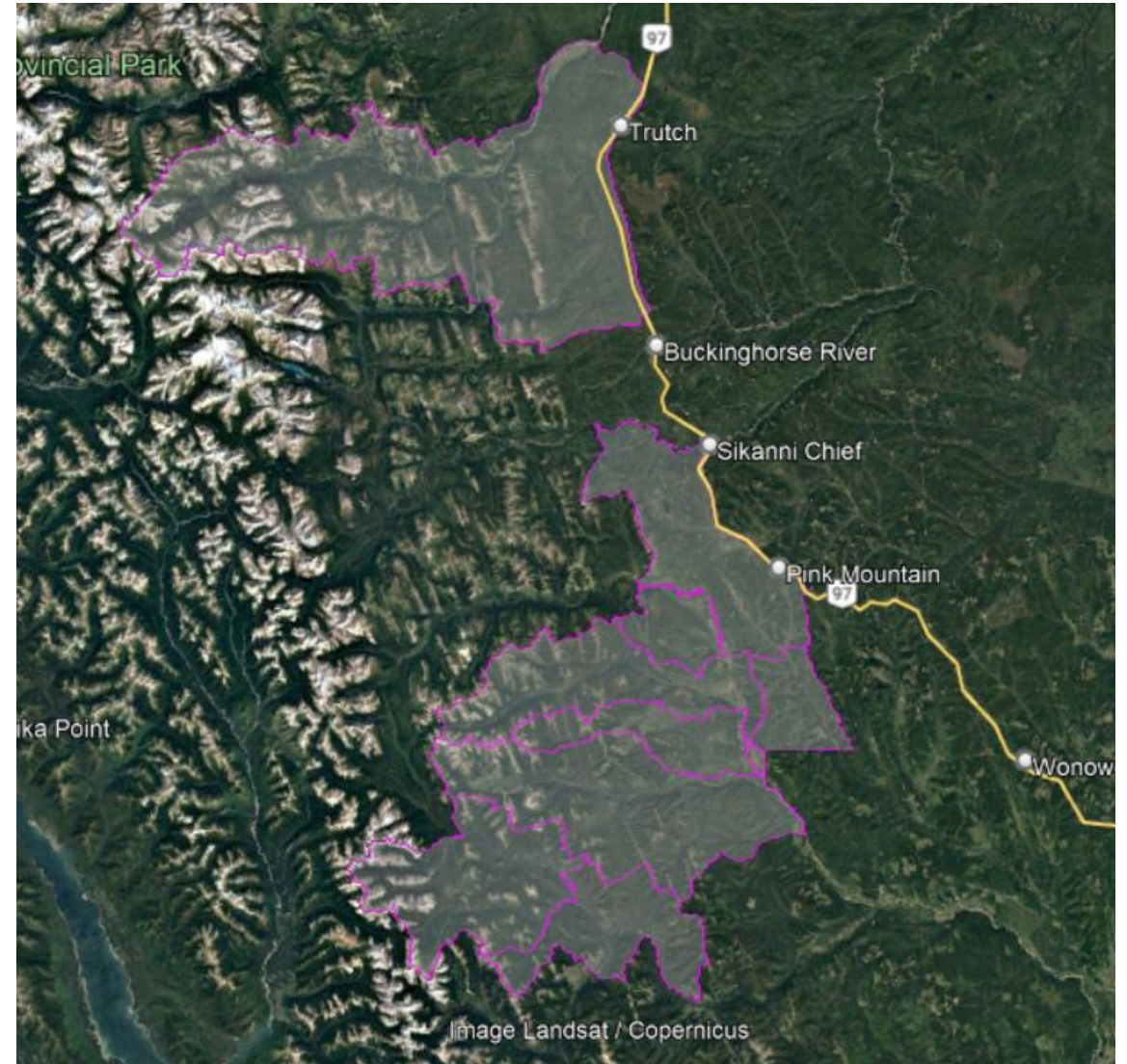


Halfway River First Nation

- **Project Location:** 9 Trapline Holder Areas
- **Restoration Goal:** Identify areas to restore and build a restoration plan for the areas
- **Benefits:** Wildlife (ungulates – reduce wolf access), community (protection of treaty rights and cultural values)

Halfway River First Nation

Project Phases:

1: Pretreatment Inventory and Planning

- Desktop review of wildlife camera images, TUS data, seismic lines, third party overlaps, existing research
- Engagement with the community, trapline owners, MFLNRORD, range and guide tenure holders, other Nations
- Field reconnaissance with trapline owners to identify candidate seismic lines and record wildlife and vegetation characteristics, cultural values
- Reporting
